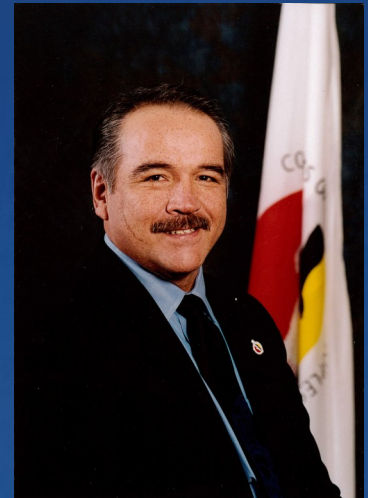
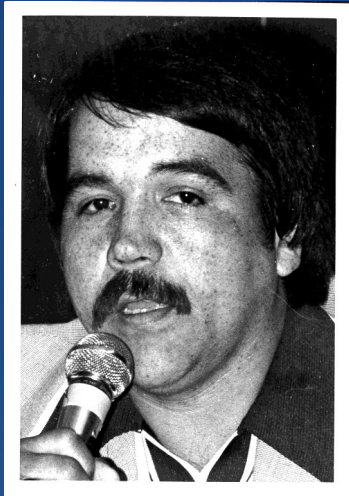


2021 Dwight Dorey Youth Advocacy Award

Eligibility Criteria

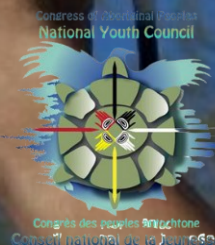
- Indigenous ancestry (Status, Non-status Indians, Métis, and Nunatunavut Inuit)
- Must be residing off-reserve
- Must be a member of CAP affiliate organization in good standing
- Demonstrating advocacy for indigenous youth initiatives and an aptitude to be a positive role model in the community
- Personal achievements that contribute to empowering/inspiring other indigenous youth in the following areas:

1. Arts, culture, music, and sports
2. Civic engagement
3. Education
4. Community and volunteer involvement
5. Awards and recognition

- Youth recipient (Age 15-29) will receive a cash reward, plaque and their profile publicized
- Adult recipient (Age 30 & up) will receive a plaque and their profile publicized
